

## SPMA Registrar's Report As of November 16, 2005

**Clubs:** We have a total of 55 clubs registered for 2005 (compared to 53 for 2004, 57 for 2003, 54 for 2002 and 55 for 2001).

Our total for 2006 as of November 16<sup>th</sup> is 103. We have over 40 clubs registered for 2006, so we're way ahead of any previous year. This is a treat for the registrar (I don't have piles of registrations waiting for the clubs) and also lets me get cards to the swimmers much faster.

I sent out 491 invoices to swimmers registered in 2004, but not 2005, for whom I didn't have email addresses. For those with email I sent the personalized email renewal that they could print out and mail with their check. I have already received quite a few of both batches back.

**Newsletter:** I am working on the Jan/Feb issue of the newsletter, and it is due next Monday. The early deadlines are in effect, they will be mailing USMS Swimmer earlier starting with the Jan/Feb issue.

**Top Ten & Records:** I still need the entry information from the LCM Nationals, since there is another question about a swimmers age.

**Library:** I have a box of tapes that have not had any use since I took over as librarian. *I would like to make a motion that these be offered to anyone on the committee and at the meet on Sunday, and if no one wants them that they be disposed of by donation.* People are now wanting DVDs.

### Votes by the Executive Committee since last meeting:

I requested that the executive committee approve the registration of "SPMA" as a club for 2006 only. This is to accommodate the unattached swimmers competing at Worlds. The SPMA EC approved this. We already have one swimmer registered to this club, and many inquiries.

I also requested that they approve a \$10 discount for club registrations postmarked before November 1<sup>st</sup>, and they did. As of November 1<sup>st</sup> we had over 30 clubs registered. As of today we have 39 registered for 2006, the most we have ever had this early.

*I would like to make the motion that the \$10 club discount for registrations postmarked before November 1<sup>st</sup> be made permanent until voted otherwise.*
