I will be submitting the LCM Top Ten before I leave for convention.

Library: Lending is very slow, probably due to vacations and summer activities.

Registration fees: *I would like to make a motion that SPMA automatically increase dues in the amount that USMS increases dues, unless voted otherwise by the committee.* I would suggest that this be our policy. This means that we will increase the 2010 dues to \$42 unless SPMA would like to vote to do otherwise. However, if USMS does something different at convention (for example, decides to raise the USMS portion of the dues \$3 rather than \$2), I would raise the total likewise. If you're confused we can talk about it on the conference call. I don't want to run into a situation where USMS does something with the dues on Saturday at convention, and I have to have the newsletter in on Monday, with no guidance at all from the committee. This would give us the default situation.
